2. After the application is received and cleared by the ELAC Cheer Coach, you will be allowed to participate in tryouts.

3. Performance Attire/Preferred Attire:

- Appropriate Athletic attire, NO Jewelry/Cover tattoos
- Female: Black running shorts (tights preferred), Male: Appropriate Athletic attire, Black basketball/loose Shorts
- White short-sleeve t-shirt (no printing on shirt preferred)
- Rubber soled shoes
- Hair pulled back in a high ponytail for long hair (female) & pulled back low (male), half up for shoulder length hair (female), & pulled back (male), nicely styled for short hair - Girls: Performance make-up /lip stick
- NO Jewelry
- No tattoos, stickers, or painting on body (cover up body tape, band-aid, or make-up is allowed)

4. Learn and practice tryout material

5. Participate in Tryouts: Participate in the Audition Interview (5-10 minutes) on Monday and Wednesday, February 14 and 16, after you have submitted your recordings

6. Receive confirmation about audition results within 10-30 minutes of audition in person
