New Courses**1. HEALTH 103 Cultural Competence in Health and Social Services (3.0) CSU LACCD Area B2 (2024)**

LECTURE, 3 HOURS.

This course examines the political, social, and theoretical perspectives of diverse populations as they relate to health and social services settings. The impact of health status, lifestyle and behavioral patterns, communication styles, socioeconomic status, personal prejudices, ethnic stereotyping, and cultural beliefs on individual and group access to health and social services will be investigated. Emphasis is placed on developing effective strategies to use with diverse populations as well as evaluating the effectiveness of existing health and social service programs.

2. KIN 250-1 Weight Training Skills I (1.0) CSU

LABORATORY, 2 HOURS.

This course introduces the basic principles and techniques of weight training. Students learn proper lifting form, safety protocols, and develop an individualized weight training program. This course focuses on building strength, muscular endurance, and overall fitness.

3. KIN 250-2 Weight Training Skills II (1.0) CSU

Prerequisite(s): Kinesiology 250-1 Weight Training Skills I (1.0)

LABORATORY, 2 HOURS.

This course expands on foundational weight training principles, introducing more advanced techniques tailored for intermediate lifters. Students explore intermediate training methods, periodization strategies, and the customization of workout programs. Emphasis will be placed on developing strength, hypertrophy, and muscular endurance, while maintaining a strong focus on proper form, safety, and effective recovery strategies.
