To graduate with an associate’s degree from LAHC, a student must have completed all of the following:

1. **Unit Requirement:** Minimum 60 degree-applicable units
2. **Scholarship Requirement:** Overall GPA of 2.0 and minimum of “C” grade or better in all major coursework.
3. **Residence Requirements:** Complete no fewer than 12 units within the LACCD District
4. **Major Requirements:** Major course requirements must be completed (in all coursework towards the major requirements) consisting of a minimum of 18 units.
5. **General Education Requirements:** Completion of LAHC local AA/AS general education pattern (F2025) or certified completion of the Cal-GETC pattern. Continuing students may complete prior LAHC GE patterns (including proficiency and graduation requirements), or certified completion of IGETC or certified completion of CSU-GE Breadth based on catalog rights and continuous attendance as defined in Administrative Procedures 4100.

Catalog Rights and Continuous Attendance (AP 4100)

College catalogs cover an academic year that reflect enrollment beginning with the fall term and includes subsequent winter, spring and summer terms. Having “Catalog Rights” means students may choose to be held to the graduation requirements listed in the catalog at the time enrollment begins in the Los Angeles Community College District (LACCD), or for any subsequent catalog year during which they maintain continuous attendance.

“Continuous attendance” means attending at least one term (fall, winter, spring, summer) each calendar year at any United States institutionally accredited institution of higher education. Courses with a “W” (withdrawal) count toward determining continuous attendance. Credit and noncredit coursework both count toward attendance.
